DC Fund Structure

In 2013-14, each fundraising activity pays 20% to DC Fund which phases out as listed. The amount each class can apply towards their trip is in parentheses:

2013-14: 20%	(subsidy up to 65% = (.65)(# seniors)(\$1,000)
2014-15: 15%	(subsidy up to 50% = (.5)(# seniors)(\$1,000)
2015-16: 10%	(subsidy up to 35% = (.35)(# seniors)(\$1,000)
2016-17: 5%	(subsidy up to 20% = (.2)(# seniors)(\$1,000)

Thereafter, fund will be closed and disbursed back to student body.
