Total Credits to graduate 230 - 5 credits awarded for each semester of a class in which a grade of C or better is earned, 10 credits for each year ('07-'08 year and earlier) of a class in which a grade of C or better is earned.

Community Service (4 semesters, 35 hours per semester) Non-credit

Internship (17 weeks, minimum of 35 hours) Non-credit

9 College Units

Students are required to complete 9 college units with a grade of D or better. Effective August 19, 2009, college classes taken to meet high school required courses will not count towards this requirement.

California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE)

In addition to all of the above requirements, students will be required to pass or complete the Math and English portions of the CAHSEE.
